Please note: Competitions will run in line with the latest COVID-19 government guidelines. Please check the Benridge Riding Centre website for the most up to date information.

We will run as Express Dressage format, to limit the number of people on site at any one time. Please only enter classes in numerical order – eg classes 1 and 2, not classes 1 and 3 as this will mean longer on site and cause problems with parking.

No results will be available on the day, and test sheets and rosettes will be posted out after the competition.

Please only come with one other person, no additional spectators will be allowed to ensure we stay within the government's social distancing guidelines.

British Dressage rules apply. If you have more than 25 points at the level above the class you are competing in, you must ride H/C. Eg – if you have more than 25 points at Novice, you must compete H/C at Prelim. Any horse and rider combination placed 1st two or more times at Benridge Riding Centre must ride H/C in future classes or compete at a higher level.

Points will be awarded for 1st – 6th place in all classes (to horse and rider combinations). Those outside of 6th place will all receive 1 point. Points will be cumulative for all four competition dates and the highest points scorers across all classes will be awarded overall prizes after the final competition.

- Warm up in outdoor arena, tests to be ridden in the indoor arena.
- Riders compete at their own risk and no responsibility will be taken by the organisers for injuries to horse, rider, spectator or vehicles.
- Approved hats with a harness must be worn at all times.
- Dress code: Stock / tie and jacket (tweed, black or navy).
- Horses tied to wagons / trailers must not be left unattended.
- Parking is in the car park and drive. Please leave the area clean and tidy and bring your own equipment to tidy up after yourself. To allow us to manage the car park effectively please don't arrive too early and leave as quickly as possible.
- It is your responsibility that all horses competing must have an up to date vaccination record, in line with the current recommendations.
