British Dressage rules apply.

Junior riders are under 16.

Juniors that are placed 1st in four or more classes at Benridge Riding Centre with more than 4 competitors will compete against adults in future competitions at the same level or go H/C.

Seniors if placed 1st four or more times in Intro and Prelim level classes at Benridge Riding Centre must ride H/C in future classes or compete at a higher level.

If you compete at BD, horse and rider combinations with more than 25 points at the level above the class you are competing in, you must ride H/C. E.g. if you have more than 25 points at Novice you must compete H/C in Prelims.

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st – 6th place in all classes.

- Riders compete at their own risk and no responsibility will be taken by the organiser for injuries to the horse, rider, spectator or vehicle.
- Approved hats with a harness must be worn at all times.
- Dress code. Stock/tie and jacket (tweed/navy or black).
- Horses left tied to wagons /trailers must not be left unattended. Please do not feed hay nets outside trailers or wagons.
- Please leave the area clean and tidy.
- It is your responsibility that all horse competing must have an upto date vaccination record in line with current recommendations.
